

> A FOCUS ON FLEXIBILITY

Here's some of the terms you may hear as you explore your options at Lethbridge College. While the language may be unfamiliar, our goals to support our students and offer an education at the time, place and pace that works for them has been the same for more than 60 years.



Asynchronous – Learning does not occur at the same time or same place. Instructor provides materials including online readings, recorded lectures or presentations, assignments and exams for online completion. Students access course materials in a flexible timeframe.



Synchronous – Learning happens in real time. Student and instructors interact and engage with each other in a specific virtual space at a specific time. Can include video conferencing, live chatting, and live-streaming lectures.



Experiential learning (EL) – An engaged learning process that involves both a “learn by doing” experience and a reflection on the experience to develop new skills, attitudes, or knowledge.



Work Integrated Learning (WIL) – A form of experiential learning that is embedded in program or course design and includes engagement of an industry or community partner. Can include a practicum, internship, service learning, field placement, mandatory clinical placement, or directed field study.



Hybrid or HyFlex – Hybrid learning includes synchronous or asynchronous online interactions that replace a portion of traditional face-to-face instruction. HyFlex (hybrid-flexible) learning integrates face-to-face classes with online learning experiences. Unlike hybrid learning, students are given the choice to attend classes in person or online, and they can switch back and forth throughout the semester.



Online – Online courses are instructor-led and conducted over the internet. Communications, teaching and assessment components are delivered solely online, and do not have any on-campus elements. They may be either synchronous or asynchronous. Students complete all their work online and are not required to come to campus.



On-campus – On-campus courses are connected to a learning management system. However, the primary means of delivery is in a synchronous, face-to-face classroom. Students will complete the majority, or all, of their work on-campus.

> CERTIFICATES, DIPLOMAS, DEGREES AND APPRENTICESHIPS

Learn more about some of the different academic credentials you can achieve at Lethbridge College.

Certificates – generally takes less than one year to complete. Considered short-term learning to prepare you to work in a specific occupation.

Diplomas – typically takes up to two years of full-time study to complete. Prepares you to work in a particular field or group of occupations.

Degrees – usually take four years of full-time study. Provides theoretical or academic learning, and can include practicums, internships or other work-integrated learning experiences.

Apprenticeships – can last between one and four years. Includes a specific number of on-the-job training hours and industry examinations.
